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Student Feedback Analysis

In the academic year 2023-2024 we collected Students feedback of all the classes and Students were asked to give their valuable feedback on Curriculum prescribed by the Solapur University as well as on administration and resources. Following was the response of the students for the questionnaire asked:

- 94 students' feedbacks were collected and analyzed.
- 89.86 % of the students rated that the curriculum is structured, comprehensive, relevant and arranged properly.
- Only 9.14 % students were rated the curriculum is not effective in developing analytical and problem solving skills.
- 89.4 % students among 94 satisfied about the faculty provide guidance for writing research assignments, research papers & projects.
- 89.4 % students find the Faculties provide additional practical examples from real life situations apart from the textbook.
- 100% students satisfied with the Library timings are adequate.
- 84 % students also satisfied with Classrooms which are equipped with LCD projectors to facilitate teaching and learning.
- Only 9.6 % students' were not satisfied with the Moot Court Hall, they feel that it not properly maintained.
- 92.6 % students were satisfied with proper availability of updated Text books/ Reference books/ General Knowledge books/ Common Entrance Exam books.

- Almost 35.3 % of students rated the syllabus “Good” when it comes to curriculum and 54.4 % said that curriculum is “Excellent”.
- 36.8 % of the students give the feedback that Curriculum is effective in developing analytical and problem solving skills and 48.5 % gives feedback that curriculum is excellent.
- 76.5 % Alumni accepted to deliver lectures for the development of their juniors. Over all the feedback of Alumni is Satisfactory.
